# DIRECTIONS TO YULE RIVER MEETING PLACE

## Flights from Perth

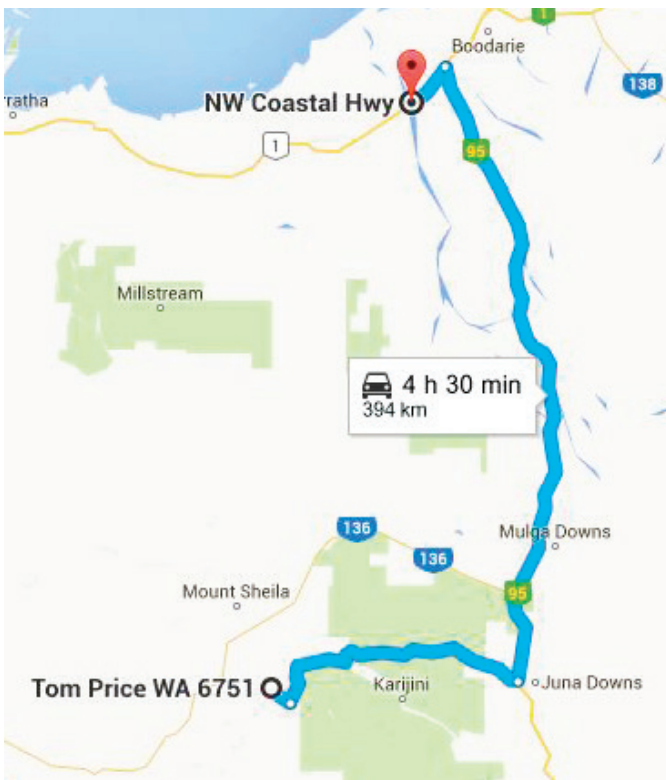
The closest airport to the Yule River Meeting Place is Port Hedland.

## Driving Directions

The Yule River Meeting Place is situated on North West Coast Highway, near the rest area on the north-western side of the Yule River bridge crossing. There will be signs posted along the sides of the road for the event, alerting you to the site.

## Directions from Tom Price (or Paraburdoo)

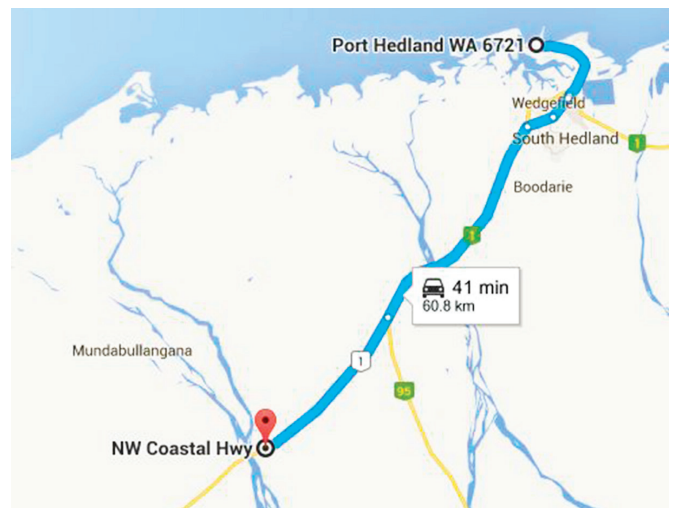
It is an approximate 400km drive from Tom Price. Upon leaving Tom Price take Karajini Road out to meet National Highway 95. Follow this until you meet the North West Coast Highway, and turn left. The Yule River Meeting Place will be on the right, just before the bridge crossing. **Total estimated drive time: 4 hours and 30 minutes.**



## Directions from Port Hedland

It is an approximate 55km drive from Port Hedland. Upon leaving Port Hedland take the Great Northern Highway. Continue straight onto North West Coast Highway for another 15 minutes (20km). The Yule River Meeting Place will be on the right, prior to the bridge crossing.

**Total estimated drive time: 40minutes.**



## Directions from Karratha

It is an approximate 180km drive from Karratha. Upon leaving Karratha take the North West Coast Highway. The Yule River Meeting Place will be on the left, just after to the bridge crossing. Total estimated drive time: 1 hour and 50 minutes.
