As a member of your native title representative body, you become part of a network of state and national organisations dedicated to ensuring Traditional Owners not only achieve native title recognition but can then make the most of this recognition once achieved.

YMAC is a leading advocate on issues affecting Traditional Owners' in managing and caring for Country.

Your membership provides an avenue to influence State and Federal government policy and law reform, and to improve or introduce new programs of support.

YMAC Members also receive important news and updates in the mail. Membership of YMAC is free.

BE PART OF THE DECISION MAKING PROCESS

Becoming a member is a great way to have a say in your land council.

YMAC Members can attend, speak and vote at the relevant Annual Regional Meeting each year, where they have the opportunity to hear about what's happening at YMAC and ask questions of the Board of Directors, Regional Committee and the Executive Management Team.

Members are eligible to be nominated or elected to the relevant Regional Committee and Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors is the highest decision-making body within YMAC. It makes important policy decisions and sets the direction for YMAC.

The Board of Directors is accountable to YMAC members. It is made up of six representatives from the Yamatji region and six representatives from the Pilbara region.
