I make this declaration for the purpose of Paragraph 4 (c) of the **Closure of Gun Shops Directions (No2)** made under section 71 of the *Emergency Management Act 2008 (WA)* to confirm:

- (a) I am an Aboriginal person entitled to exercise a native title right to hunt over particular land and waters as I fall within the definition of native title holders and/or the claim group description for the _____ native title determination/application; and
- (b) That the owner, occupier or person apparently in charge of a gun shop may open that place by appointment to enable me to purchase ammunition or firearms or both and to have repairs done to my firearm/s.

Academic (post-secondary institution), Accountant, Architect, Australian Consular Officer, Australian Diplomatic Officer, Bailiff, Bank Manager, Chartered Secretary, Governance Adviser or Risk Manager, Chemist, Chiropractor, Company auditor or liquidator, Court officer (Judge, magistrate, registrar or clerk or the chief executive officer, of any court of the State or the Commonwealth), Defence Force officer (Commissioned, Warrant or Non Commissioned Officer with 5 years continuous service), Dentist, Doctor, Electorate officer of a member of State Parliament, Engineer, Industrial organisation secretary, Insurance broker, Justice of the Peace, Landgate officer, Lawyer, Local government CEO or deputy CEO, Local government councillor, Loss adjuster, Marriage Celebrant, Member of Parliament (State or Commonwealth), Midwife, Minister of religion, Nurse, Optometrist, Paramedic, Patent Attorney, Physiotherapist, Podiatrist, Police officer, Post Officer manager, Psychologist, Public Notary, Public Servant (State or Commonwealth), Real Estate agent, Settlement agent, Sheriff or deputy Sheriff, Surveyor, Teacher (Registered Teacher), Tribunal officer, Veterinary surgeon
